H1N1 Vaccine Clinics

The Lee County Health Department (LCHD) has announced additional clinics for the general public to receive the H1N1 vaccine and for children 9 years of age and under to their 2nd dose.

Dates: Thursday, January 21 from 4:00 – 6:00pm
 Thursday, January 28 from 4:00 – 6:00pm
 Thursday, February 18 from 4:00 – 6:00pm

H1N1 Vaccine is available in the shot form as well as nasal spray.

The clinic on January 21st will allow children 9 years of age and under who had their first dose prior to December 22nd to receive a 2nd dose.

The clinic on January 28 will allow children 9 years of age and under who had their first dose prior to December 31st to receive a 2nd dose.

The clinic on February 18 will allow children 9 years of age and under who had their first dose prior to January 22nd to receive a 2nd dose.

Fighting the flu is a shared responsibility. We ask you to join us in this fight to protect yourself and your community by getting the H1N1 flu vaccine.

There will be no charge for receiving the H1N1 vaccination from the LCHD.
